2019 WACE \$15,000 CWIE RESEARCH GRANT

WACE and the WACE International Research Community (IRC) are pleased to announce the \$15,000 CWIE Research Grant for 2019. WACE established the research grant, now in its third edition, to promote research activity that will advance and strengthen the understanding of cooperative and work-integrated education (CWIE) in post-secondary/tertiary education across the globe. One grant of \$15,000 will be awarded to the successful application.

THE APPLICATION PERIOD ENDS ON MARCH 1, 2019.

The grant will focus within one of the identified WACE research themes. The five (5) research themes are:

1. Mapping and Reconciling Goals and Expectations Across Multiple Stakeholders
2. Social and Political Trends - including gender, race, socio-economic status, and accessibility
3. Assessment and Evaluation
4. Graduate Attributes
5. Transfer of Learning

An awarded study may sample from a variety of disciplines, but the study findings must address one of the themes listed above.
